A short update.

The Proceedings of Cambridge Antiquarian Society have been put online via the Archaeological Data Service (along with the Transactions of the Cambridgeshire and Huntingdonshire Archaeological Society). Links have been added to the references in relevant Gatehouse pages. The links in the <u>'Journals'</u> page have been check and updated where needed.

Duncan Wright, Oliver Creighton, Michael Fradley and Steven Trick have written a paper, published in Medieval Settlement Research, on Castle Carlton, Lincolnshire and the records for the Castle and the Borough have been updated. In particular the record for the borough is significantly changed as they now locate this failed borough as separate and further east from the castle and, therefore,
